Miele Canada Expands Commitment to Reforestation and Forest Preservation with Fourth Annual Miele Forest Initiative

Toronto – April 1, 2025

Miele Canada proudly launches the fourth annual Miele Forest Initiative, further strengthening its commitment to sustainability. From April 1 to June 30, 2025, every Miele dishwasher, washing machine, and dryer purchased in Canada contributes to preserving and restoring Canadian forests. This initiative aligns with Miele's core value of making a positive, sustainable environmental impact.

"True sustainability is about making choices that stand the test of time. With the Miele Forest Project, we empower our customers to invest in quality while actively contributing to reforestation and conservation efforts across Canada," says Ekaterina Dobrokhotova, Vice President of Marketing.

In partnership with LivClean, Miele Canada supports key conservation projects, including the Great Bear Forest Carbon Project in British Columbia. Spanning over 14 million acres of coastal temperate rainforest within the traditional territories of nine First Nations, this project protects old-growth forests and supports Indigenous communities.

Miele Canada is also supporting two additional reforestation projects:

- Ontario Post Logging and Mining Reforestation: Decades of industrial activity, including logging, nickel, and copper mining, have left vast areas in Greater Sudbury barren and heavily contaminated. Miele's support will help restore these degraded lands, enhance biodiversity, and contribute to the long-term health of local ecosystems.
- British Columbia Post-Fire Reforestation: Devastating wildfires in 2017, 2018, and 2021 scorched over 1.3 million hectares of forest in Cariboo, BC, severely impacting wildlife and Indigenous communities. Miele's contributions will support reforestation and assisted natural regeneration to help revive these vital ecosystems.

Our Impact

Since the inception of the Miele Forest Initiative in 2022, Miele Canada has made measurable progress in forest conservation. To date, the initiative's impact is equivalent to:

- 100,420 trees planted
- 10,042,000 kilograms of CO2 captured
- Offsetting emissions equal to 308,510 years of dishwashing
